School Site Council (SSC) was implemented to provide support to the school and staff for the greater good of the students. At Grant the council is composed of 5 members; the school principal, one teacher, one classified staff member, and two elected parents. Your SSC is responsible for developing a school improvement plan (The Single Plan for Student Achievement); providing input in the LCAP (Local Control Accountability Plan) which is the budget and periodically assessing the school program. SSC is advisory in nature and a necessary element in qualifying for and receiving various categorical funding sources. The Title I funds and LCAP dollars help pay for things such as: Language Arts and Math Intervention Teachers, our Library Technician, Literacy Technicians, technology, books and other supplemental materials. School Site Council meets once a month for approximately one hour during the school year, from October through May. At this time, due to COVID 19, our meetings will be held virtually through Google Meets.
