Tk-5 Reopening Plan

Students participating in onsite blended learning will attend school 5 days per week. The school schedule will be an AM/PM Cohort model, coupled with daily home assignments. Students remaining on Distance Learning will continue with the current instructional schedule. Students will remain in their program of choice until January 22.

Onsite Blended Learning Program

AM Cohort: 8:10-10:40 am

PM Cohort: 12:10-2:40 pm

Based on their grade level, students will have a certain number of minutes of asynchronous homework each day to supplement the site-based instruction. Cohorts of students will stay with their teacher throughout their learning day.

Families will be notified if they are in the AM or PM cohort on Monday, November 9.

Classroom Spaces and Social Distancing

- Classrooms will be thoroughly disinfected daily between cohorts and after school.
- Classrooms will be arranged with spaces between desks and students will be instructed on how to be safe in their classroom environments.
- Our school will have social distancing markers and directional signs to ensure proper spacing in our hallways.
- Teachers will arrange their lessons and choice time activities to facilitate space between students.
- Supplies will be provided to students for individual use.
- Per County Public Health guidelines, face coverings must be worn by all students and adults.

School Arrival and Departure

- Students may arrive **no more than 10 minutes** before their cohort start time and must be picked up promptly at dismissal time.
- There will be no before or after school care program.
- Parents/Guardians must complete a health screening survey at home daily, prior to students arriving on campus.
- The District may provide limited bus service based on transportation hardship.

- Parents/Guardians will not walk their children to class. Rather, they will drop them off at identified entry points.
- Visitors are not permitted.
- Everyone on campus must wear a mask.
- Upon entering the classroom or any other building on campus, students will wash their hands with soap and water and/or have access to hand sanitizer.

Breakfast and Lunch Program

- Breakfast/Lunch will not be eaten on campus. The district will provide “grab and go” lunches/breakfasts to be taken as students exit the campus.

Signs or Symptoms of COVID-19

- Parents/Guardians must complete a health screening survey at home daily, prior to students arriving on campus.
- Students will be sent home if it is determined that they display COVID-19 symptoms.
- Administration will work with the County Public Health Department to notify families and staff of potential exposure.
